

Invitation to attend the Plant Food Summit

Brussels, 17 October

On behalf of the Vegetarian Society of Denmark, one of the event partners, SAFE is happy to invite you to the official EU Presidency Conference Plant Food Summit, on 20-21 October, at the Royal Danish Playhouse, in Copenhagen.

Around 350 international guests and 150 Danish representatives will gather to explore how plant-based foods can contribute to Europe's goals on climate, health and competitiveness. The Danish Minister for Food, Agriculture and Fisheries Jacob Jensen will open the event, which also includes the European launch of the new [EAT Lancet report](#), one of the most influential scientific reviews of food systems and dietary guidelines.

The summit is organised by a broad partnership across agriculture, industry, research, NGOs and government, creating a unique forum for balanced dialogue between advocates and sceptics on the future of food and farming in Europe.

Media are invited to attend and can request interviews with international speakers including actress and environmental advocate Kate Mara, researchers from the EAT Lancet Commission and senior representatives from European agriculture and industry.
